The Excell Program is an ongoing effort by volunteer engineers, scientists, and other professionals to stimulate more interest and enhance performances in technical subjects by students in the Black Community. The program provides tutoring/mentoring classes in Math, the Sciences, Computer Applications and Scholastic Aptitude Test Preparation for students in Grades 2 through 12.

Classes are conducted on Saturdays using classrooms and facilities provided by the University.

The Spring 2009 Session starts on February 28 and ends on May 16, 2009. Typically, Students will attend two, 1-1/2 hour classes each Saturday between 9 AM and Noon. A field trip to the Jet Propulsion Laboratory is scheduled for Saturday, April 4, 2009. No classes will be held on Easter weekend

Although the program is a non-profit venture, there is a nominal fee for each student. The fee for this session is \$75.00. This fee will cover all textbooks and the Field Trip. A Discount will be available for siblings of registered students and, as needed, for students from lower income households.
