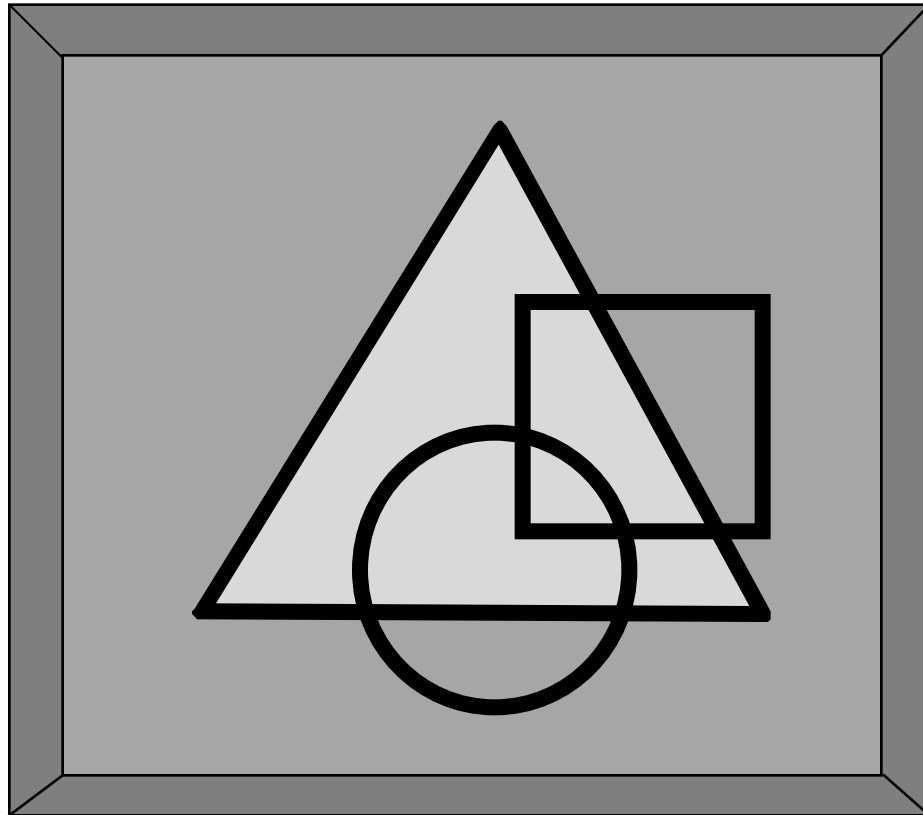

**AL-BEN SCHOLARSHIP**

**Awards and Incentive Program**

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The Al-Ben Scholarship fund was established by the Los Angeles Council of Black Professional Engineers (LACBPE) in 1976 to provide awards and incentives to technically inclined pre-college and undergraduate students enrolled in engineering, mathematical computer studies or scientific studies (chemistry, physics).

The objective of the program is to stimulate and support the student's interest in these technical areas that traditionally have an under-representation of minority professionals. The program therefore seeks to encourage the student through scholarship awards and public recognition to maintain the high level of academic performance needed for successful careers in these fields.

**The scholarship is open to students attending college in the United States, however, preference will be given to students that are Los Angeles area (Southern California) residents.**

Three types of awards will be granted: Scholastic Achievement Awards, Professional Merit Awards, and Academic Excellence Incentive Awards. The criteria for award in each category are described below. The anticipated value of each award is also listed below, however, these amounts and number of awards may vary at the discretion of the scholarship review committee based upon the number of scholarships awarded, and caliber of applications received.

**Scholastic Achievement Awards:**

Estimated Value: \$500 - \$1000.00

This scholarship will be granted based primarily upon the superlative scholastic achievements in the academic pursuits of engineering, math, computer studies or scientific studies education. A minimum of two awards will be given in this category, one at the high school level, one at the undergraduate college level.

**Professional Merit Awards:**

Estimated Value: \$500 - \$1000.00

This scholarship will be granted based upon exemplary actions in campus organizations, or community activities, while maintaining an excellent grade point average thereby demonstrating their dedication to professionalism. A minimum of two awards will be given in this category, one at the high school level, one at the undergraduate college level.

**Academic Incentive Awards:**

Estimated Value: \$500 - \$1000.00

This scholarship award will be granted based on the student's notable academic achievements, interests in engineering, math or science, and demonstrated desire and commitment to succeed in technical fields. Two awards may be given in this category, one at the high school level, one at the undergraduate college level.

In returning the completed application, the student will be considered for each of the awards for which they are qualified. Each student will be eligible to receive only one award. All applicants will receive notification of their application not later than April 30, 2004.

To apply for a 2004 AL-BEN Scholarship Award, please complete the following application package and return it to address on back page. **Packages must be postmarked by March 5, 2004.**

You should return everything, including the letters of recommendation in one package.
